



## Trinity Christian School Association Constitution

### Article 1

The name of the society is TRINITY CHRISTIAN SCHOOL ASSOCIATION, referred to as the society.

### Article 2

The prime purpose of the society is to give children an opportunity to receive a thorough, God-centered and biblically based education, endeavoring to prepare them for the future.

#### ***Spiritually, the society seeks:***

- To teach the need for a heart, mind and life given over completely to the Lord Jesus Christ, according to the scriptures.
- To foster a growing desire to know the God of the Bible.
- To help the students come to a point where they want to accept and please God.
- To build strong and righteous characters.

#### ***Academically, the society seeks:***

- To teach the subject in the light of the Holy Scriptures.
- To cover and enrich all of the academic skills required in Alberta Education's *Guide to Education and Program of Studies*.
- To provide (in consultation and/or with the support of the parents/guardian) an Individual Education Program for those with learning and/or physical disabilities in order to reach their potential.
- To encourage the gifted and talented students to use and further develop their areas of expertise, and to recognise this as a gift from the Lord by which, in turn, they can serve Him.

***Physically, Emotionally and Socially the Society seeks:***

- To teach behavior and morals in accordance to the Word of God.
- To teach the practice of self-discipline in all studies, work habits, interpersonal relationships and behavior.
- To teach the need for, and practice of, a proper balance of work, exercise and relaxation for a strong and healthy body.
- To foster right attitudes in the students towards themselves, their personality and attitudes, and towards others. *Jesus, Others, Yourself - JOY.*
- To promote good citizenship

**Article 3**

***Philosophy***

Since God created and sustains everything through His Son, the Lord Jesus Christ, this world and Life were created by God, as stated in the Scriptures, and our goal should be to glorify Him.

Man, being a sinner by nature, can glorify God only by being reborn in God's image through repentance and committing his life to Jesus Christ as Savior and Lord.

Our total process of education, therefore, must seek the restoration of our students to the position of true knowledge, righteousness, and holiness in Christ by developing and relating the whole person to God, spiritually, mentally and physically. We must present God's truth and interpret it by, and integrate it with, God's Word, the Bible.

Although such education is primarily the parent's responsibility, we, the Trinity Christian School Association, it's faculty and board, function as an extension of the home to aid parents or guardians in the education of their child.

This provision is alterable.

**Article 4**

***Statement of faith***

We believe;

In the only true and living God, Creator of all things, existing in three persons: Father, Son and Holy Spirit.

In the deity and the humanity of Jesus Christ, His virgin birth, His sinless life, His vicarious and atoning death on the cross, His bodily resurrection from the dead, His ascension to the right hand of the Father

as our Intercessor and High Priest and in His personal, imminent, premillennial return in power and great glory.

In the infilling and indwelling of the child of God by the Holy Spirit to guiding, instructing and empowering the believer for holy living service. Christ in you, the Hope of Glory.

In the personality of Satan, who as a fallen angel, is the enemy of the Triune God, the saints, and the angels.

In the fall of man and the universal separation of the human race from a righteous God

That salvation from this lost condition is only found through faith in Jesus Christ and in his substitutionary death.

In the physical resurrection of all men. Of the believer to everlasting life with the Lord, and the unbeliever to everlasting separation in the lake of fire.

The Scriptures, both Old and New Testaments, to be the verbally inspired, inerrant, Word of God, the complete revelation of His will for the salvation of men, and the final and only authority for the believer.

We recognise that there are other doctrines held by various Christian believers which they believe to be consistent with the above. Such doctrines shall not be promoted by this society.

This provision is unalterable.

## **Article 5**

### ***Dissolution***

In the event of winding up or dissolution of the Society, and funds of the Society remaining after the satisfaction of its debts and liabilities, shall be given or transferred as the board sees fit (not forgetting recognition of pensions or staff service), to such organisations which are in total agreement with the statement of faith, Article 4 of the constitution of this society.

This provision is unalterable.

## **Article 6**

### ***Non-Profit***

The society shall be carried on without the purpose of gain for its board members, and any profits or other accretions to the Society shall be used for promoting its objectives.

This provision is unalterable.
